



Consent to Disclosure of Tax Return Information

Federal law requires this consent form to be provided to you. Unless authorized by law we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax return information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use of distribution.

If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

If this consent authorizes the disclosure of a full copy of your tax return or all information contained within your tax return, you have the right to request a more limited disclosure of tax return information at any time, resulting in this agreement no longer being valid.
